

Call for Artists

Submission Deadline: October 15, 2017

Project Summary

Sarasota County Government, Englewood Community Redevelopment Area (CRA) is announcing a public art project, initiated to bring opportunities for Englewood visual artists to showcase local talents into public spaces; further expand the reach of the arts; broaden public exposure and to welcome cultural tourism to the Englewood area.

ARTWORK will be installed in the new Art Scape sculpture garden in the 400 block of W. Green St. With the aid of dedicated funding provided by the Englewood CRA and through a competitive and professionally juried selection process, Englewood visual artists are invited to create and submit original ARTWORK. Seven pieces of ARTWORK will be selected and displayed in the sculpture garden for a period of three years.

Project Goals

- Encourage, promote and support the talents and visibility of Englewood visual artists by expanding public exhibition opportunities;
- Provide unique opportunities for an all-inclusive viewing public to access and enjoy visual art beyond a gallery or museum experience at their convenience, and "admission free"
- Stimulate the local economy by welcoming & increasing cultural tourism;
- Provide creative experiences in unexpected public places by integrating the arts into non-traditional venues and transforming the ordinary, into the extraordinary;
- Provide a catalyst for dialogue; encourage socialization;
- Graffiti deterrent;
- Create and encourage partnership opportunities;
- Responds to the Englewood CRA Plan PI-10 (Create "heart of the Arts" Improvement Program;
- Change the present collective mindset to expect public art throughout our community as the "new normal":

Benefit to Visual Artists

- \$500 honorarium for each artist whose ARTWORK is selected; and any proceeds from sponsorships will be split amongst the artists.
- Wide distribution of companion tourism booklet identifying/highlighting featured ARTWORKs and artists and encouraging public touring;
- ARTWORK accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for 3+ years







Eligibility

This competitive opportunity is open to all established and emerging 3D visual ARTISTS in the Englewood community.

Selection Process and Design Criteria

The selection panel will be comprised of arts professionals from a variety of visual arts disciplines. ARTWORK will be judged for artistic excellence, technical merit, the ability to complement the setting where it will be displayed and how well the ARTWORK translates into large scale viewing.

- ARTIST declares that submitted ARTWORK does not constitute a breach of any intellectual property, copyright, trademark or brand and agrees to hold Sarasota County and the Englewood CRA harmless from any legal action arising from such claims against the submitted ARTWORK.
- ARTIST will be responsible to maintain the ARTWORK during the duration of the display keeping it free from graffiti and repairing the ARTWORK if damaged.
- The ARTIST will submit a photographic or colored rendering for each entry.

Late and/or incomplete entries will not be accepted.

Uniform Mounting Plates:

Based on the dimensions and weight of the ARTWORK an engineer will design the base. This information is necessary at the time of submittal.

Artist Submission Guidelines:

Specifications: ARTWORK may not exceed eight (8) feet in height. (Additional height requests will be reviewed on a case by case basis). ARTWORK must be uplifting, colorful and appropriate for people of all ages. ARTWORK must not contain any advertisements, promotions, political or religious themes, traffic sign element that might confuse a passing motorist or text (any lettering/verbiage). ARTISTS may submit up to 4 (four) entries. No entry fee is required.

Judging/Entry Requirements:

- ARTWORK will be judged from a glossy borderless photograph, model or a scaled color rendering.
- ARTWORK will be judged for artistic excellence, technical merit, the ability to complement the
 environment where it will be displayed, and how well it translates into large scale viewing.
- ARTWORK must be uplifting, colorful & appropriate for people of all ages (children seniors). It should reflect local values, culture, history and the natural environment, and be as "site-specific" as possible (well suited to the site/area).
- ARTWORK must not contain any advertisements, business or product promotions, political or religious points of view, text (lettering/verbiage, or contain any traffic sign element that might confuse a passing motorist.
- ARTWORK will be considered as permanent display with a life expectancy of 3+ years.
- ARTIST retains copyright of original ARTWORK; however ARTIST grants the CRA and Sarasota County permission to reproduce ARTWORK for publicity and promotion.
- If selected, ARTIST agrees to deliver the original ARTWORK by the date specified above.

Notification / Delivery / Pick-up of ARTWORK

Following jury selections, ARTISTS whose ARTWORK was selected will be notified by phone and e-mail. Reference prints will NOT be returned. Non-winning entries will be notified by the Englewood CRA. Selected ARTISTS will be required to deliver original ARTWORK to Triangle Park (Green and Cherokee Street) by the submission date.
